Driving Increased, Effective Multi-stakeholder Collaboration In Pursuit Of The SDGs

BSR is launching a **5 year**, **2,5M USD** partnership with Sida to increase and deepen the effective contribution of the private sector to achieving the 2030 agenda and the goal of reducing poverty globally.

Workstream 1 - New Collaborations

- ✓ Launch of up to 10 multi-stakeholder collaborations ✓ focusing on driving progress towards the SDGs.
- ✓ Engagement of over 400 relevant stakeholders through convenings on emerging collaboration issues.
- At least 100 companies and stakeholders join collaborations launched through the partnership, contributing to SDG related impacts

Workstream 2 - Meta Collaborations

- 2 3 meta-collaborations, aligning existing collaborations or coalitions with shared objectives and strategies
- Improved coordination between existing collaborations and uptake of good practices and effective methodologies for enhanced impact on the SDGs.
- ✓ Greater awareness of and commitment to partnerships in pursuit of the SDGs, especially the private sector.

The partnership supports Sida's objectives of "promoting strengthened partnership and leadership, greater knowledge and engagement among a range of actors able to contribute to the global implementation of the 2030 Agenda; in particular strengthening capacity and learning in the private sector for the global implementation of the 2030 Agenda."

Gender Equality

Understand differentiated impacts on men and women and outline their different roles, challenges, and barriers in the just transition.



Human Rights

Identify impacts on human rights and key rightsholders including vulnerable groups and understand role of duty bearers in fulfilling rightsholders' rights.



Climate & Environment

Assess opportunities to positively contribute to environmentally sustainable development and mitigate potential adverse impacts on the environment or climate vulnerability.




Conflict
