Climate and a Responsible Transition in Asia

Climate change and the energy transition in Asia will be a point of strategic alignment between the US, China, and other countries due to the increasing awareness and focus on the impacts of climate change globally; how this impacts energy infrastructure in the region will be a point of competitive, possibly political pressure as energy choices will be linked to national investment decisions.



03 Human Rights and the "S" in ESG

Human rights will become bifurcated. Engagement on human rights within normal business processes - modern slavery, working conditions, land acquisition, graft and corruption – will have a growing consensus for corporate transparency, responsibility and accountability across the region; the elements of human rights particularly related to social control – digital, surveillance, expression, privacy, will become increasingly complex and difficult to navigate.
