Position Overview

BSR is seeking to engage two talented interns for our Copenhagen office for the fall of 2019 – one for the BSR Collaborative Initiative the Maritime Anti-Corruption Network (MACN), and one for a broader range of tasks within BSR. Internship candidates should have a strong interest in working with companies to integrate sustainability into business strategies and further BSR's mission to create a just and sustainable world.

We are looking for someone who exhibits analytical thinking, curiosity, and a passion for sustainable business. Responsibilities include research, analysis, communications, direct client work, and the ability to understand and contribute to BSR's unique organizational model. The intern will work closely with BSR staff to address current business challenges and develop solutions to some of today's most important global sustainability issues.

Internship candidates should be enrolled in a postgraduate program and must be eligible to receive credits/points from the internship. The internship is ideally full time for a period of 4-6 months, but this can be modified according to the student's situation as well as the prospect of receiving credits from your university (3 months as a minimum).

Responsibilities

The below applies to both intern positions:

- **Research and analysis:** Conduct primary and secondary research on a broad spectrum of market, stakeholder, and policy issues and perform rigorous quantitative and qualitative analysis of data and information.
- **Advisory services:** Collaborate with BSR staff on work with clients across several industries and topical areas. Activities may include assisting on projects for senior-level clients and conducting original research and analysis.
- **Writing and communications:** Prepare and/or edit written reports and briefs targeted at a business audience and develop and deliver written and oral presentations.

- Strategy: Help BSR advance business and research opportunities through analysis of trends and market conditions. Liaise with senior-level management on issues, trends, and market conditions.

Qualifications

Intern for BSR

The focus of the intern position for BSR generally is to support BSRs increased presence in the Scandinavian region and implementation of BSR's [Collaborative Initiatives](#).

Required qualifications for this position are:

- Education: Bachelor's degree, strong academic and professional record, and current enrollment in relevant postgraduate program.
- Skills: Exceptional oral and written English, research, presentation, organization, facilitation, and interpersonal skills.
- Technical expertise: Microsoft Office (Excel, PowerPoint, Word). Advanced skills in Excel.
- Speaking Danish, Swedish or Norwegian and be fluent in English.
- Interest or experience with climate change, human rights or supply chain management.

The intern will work with the Collaborative Initiative the [Maritime Anti-Corruption Network](#) (MACN) and may in addition to the responsibilities described above assist on collective action projects, tool development, and ad hoc tasks for MACN.

- Interest or experience in maritime industry, anti-corruption or compliance work.
